PURPOSE AND PHILOSOPHY

The USASA coaching license course is designed to train amateur coaches in current coaching methodology, team administration and player preparation for all levels of competition. The better we train our coaches the better our teams and players will be. It has been statistically proven beyond any doubt that teams led by certified coaches are more successful and play with a higher level of sportsmanship. USASA has launched a successful program offering a condensed USSF approved course to train and license coaches. The course is conducted on 3 ½ successive days usually as follows:

Team Management
Care and Prevention of Injuries
Spirit of the Laws of the Game
Ethical components of soccer coaching

LEVEL 2

Methods of Soccer Coaching II
Tactics Theory I
Match analysis and reading the Game
Technical Training I
Tactical Training I
Practice Coaching

LEVEL 3

Tactics Theory II and systems of play
Technical Training II
Tactical Training II
Goalkeeper Functional Training
Practical Coaching and written Exams

Certification

All attendees completing the course will get a Diploma. Those who successfully pass the exams get the USASA/USSF license. Those who excel in the course may get a recommendation that will serve as a waiver to the USSF “C” License and the NSCAA National courses.

Handouts

Every student will receive educational material on the following subjects. Team Management, Team Administration, Spirits of the Laws of the Game, Technical Training I & II, & Goalkeeping training principles. They will also receive copies if the “Laws of the Game”, “Methods of Soccer coaching” and “Basic Soccer techniques”
